Dear Mr. Dwoskin:

Pursuant to the Authority contained in the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, and the Federal Grant and Cooperative Agreement Act of 1977, the Agency for International Development (hereinafter referred to as "A.I.D." or "Grantor") hereby amends the subject grant. The purposes of this amendment are to provide incremental funding in the amount of \$811,125, and to modify the Program Description.

This grant is effective and obligation is made as of the date of this letter and shall apply to commitments made by the Recipient in furtherance of program objectives through the dates listed in the Fiscal Data. Funds disbursed by A.I.D. but uncommitted by the Recipient at the expiration of this period shall be refunded to A.I.D.

The total estimated amount of the program is \$13,500,000 of which \$811,125 is hereby obligated. A.I.D. shall not be liable for reimbursing the Recipient for any costs in excess of the obligated amount.

This additional funding is provided to NAS on condition that the funds will continue to be administered in accordance with the terms and conditions as set forth in the Cooperative Agreement and all attachments thereto.

The subject Cooperative Agreement is hereby amended as follows:

Under Attachment 1, Schedule, make the following changes:

A. ARTICLE II - PERIOD OF AGREEMENT, FUNDS OBLIGATED, PAYMENT AND ESTIMATED COST

Under paragraph B.2, delete the amount of "\$5,175,000" and insert in lieu thereof "~~\$811,125~~".


B. Supplementary Program Description



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Supplementary Program Description

A. Agricultural Technology Research and Development (Innovative Science and Technology For Development) - (\$50,000)

The recipient proposes to conduct a state-of-the-art study of sustainable agriculture in the humid and sub-humid tropics.

The study is being conducted by a multidisciplinary panel of experts convened by the National Research Council including scientists from developing countries. Global geographic coverage is proposed. Proposed components of the study include:

Analysis of state-of-the-art of sustainable agricultural techniques in the humid and sub-humid tropics with an emphasis on interactions among the agricultural, forestry, and environmental sectors;

- A summary of ongoing efforts to develop, promote, and adopt sustainable agriculture within the humid and sub-humid tropics and institutional economic obstacles to adoption;
- Quantification of the potential carbon cycle and climate change benefits that could be attained by introducing sustainable agriculture on a large scale discussed by biome;
- Identification of opportunities for introduction and maintenance of sustainable agriculture including analyses of agroforestry, horticulture, and non-traditional crops that have potential for sustained production within the humid and sub-humid regions; and
- Presentation of policy and technical options for the future that are likely to lead to sustainable agricultural development and resultant carbon cycle benefits.

Proposed outputs of this task include both scholarly analysis of the subject and options for and consequences of potential actions as follows:

- Analytical state-of-the-art publications that describe technical and socioeconomic components of sustainable agriculture;

- Analysis of the impacts of adoption of sustainable agriculture including assessment of its potential impact on deforestation; and
- Identification of policy and technical options for sustainable agriculture including discussions of target populations, locational opportunities for adoption, and scale of intervention.

B. S&T Bureau Small Activities Project - Seminar Series on Science in Development - (\$36,125)

The recipient proposes to continue the luncheon seminar series, "Science in Development," jointly sponsored with the Agency for International Development. The recipient's Proposal No. 90-255, dated May 1990, is incorporated by reference into the Program Description.

C. Sustainable Agricultural Systems - CRSP (Planning)
(\$389,500 - S&T/AGR; \$200,000 - S&T/RD/RRD)

The recipient proposes to provide:

- A detailed program plan which will be used to make decisions for implementing a 5 to 10 year Sustainable Agricultural Systems CRSP project;
- Criteria to select the institution that will perform the functions of the administrative entity; and
- Recommendations on organizational structure to be established by the administrative entity for research and dissemination of results.

The recipient's Proposal No. 90-259, dated June 1990, with the specific modifications listed in a Memorandum of July 5, 1990 from D. Bathrick (S&T/AGR), E. Chetwynd (S&T/RD), and J. Daly (SCI), is incorporated by reference into the Program Description.

D. Transition to Democracy Workshop - (\$90,000)

The recipient proposes to organize a three-day workshop on "democratization" -- the process of transition to a democratic society and economy. The workshop is proposed to explore issues that concern the senior management of the Agency for International Development as it considers how best to direct its program in order to encourage the development of democratic societies.

It is proposed that the symposium will involve 12 to 15 experts including political scientists, sociologists, legal scholars, economists, and others expert in processes of political, economic, and social change. Through the discussions at the symposium, participants will attempt to identify and define the major elements that characterize effective democratic societies; identify critical steps necessary to support the transition to such societies; and appropriate interventions that A.I.D. might make to assist such transitions. The recipient proposes to ask the participants to identify a research agenda. Ample time is to be provided for questions and discussion between the experts and senior A.I.D. program managers.

The recipient proposes to issue a report of the conference proceedings, which A.I.D. intends to distribute widely within the agency.

The recipient's Proposal No. 91-017, dated July 1990, is incorporated by reference into the Program Description.

E. Project Development & Support (\$45,500)

Recipient proposes to conduct a country study on intellectual property rights (IPR), using Pakistan as the subject of the study. The purpose of the study is to provide a thorough background study of the IPR system in Pakistan and its impact on present and future A.I.D. programs there. The NAS proposes to convene a panel for oversight of the study. It is proposed that the study will include the following:

1. A thorough description of the current IPR laws (patent, copyright, trademark) in Pakistan, including the identification of those products and processes which are protected and those which are excluded from protection, duration of protection and the use of compulsory licensing;
2. A description of the implementation and enforcement of Pakistani IPR laws;
3. Identification of key constraints and policy issues in Pakistan affecting the development of a more effective IPR regime;
4. A discussion of impact of the IPR situation on the A.I.D. current portfolio and future activities, particularly in respect to the Mission's movement into the areas of trade and investment and technology transfer; and
5. Recommendations identifying efforts which would expand U.S. - Pakistan discussions on IPR and facilitate future ANE science and technology activities.

ANE activities in science and technology are of a broader nature than those supported by the Science Advisor's Office, moving beyond the research phase and including technology commercialization. Therefore, the study proposes to address the spectrum of science and technology activities.
