



1. Pursuant to Section 531 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, I hereby authorize the United Nations Development Program (UNDP) Complementary Support Project to USAID's Administration of Justice Program for Peru involving planned obligations not to exceed \$260,969 in grant funds over a one year period from the date of authorization, subject to the availability of funds in accordance with the A.I.D. OYB/allotment process, to help in financing foreign exchange and local currency costs for the project. The planned life of the project is twelve months from the date of initial obligation.

2. The project consists of technical assistance through the UNDP to continue administrative support to the Office of the Court Administrator within the Judicial Branch of the Government of Peru.

3. The Grant Agreement which may be negotiated and executed by the Officer to whom such authority is delegated in accordance with A.I.D. regulations and Delegations of Authority shall be subject to the following essential terms and covenants and major conditions, together with such other terms and conditions as A.I.D. may deem appropriate.

a. UNDP/Peru Resident Representative agrees to permit access to UNDP/Peru records to either a contracted audit firm or USAID/Peru Financial Analysts, to perform a financial review of the activities financed under the Grant.

b. the Grantee will assure that the individuals financed under the Grant are not employees of the GOP and, consequently, not receiving salaries from the GOP or other parties during the term of the Grant.
