The above named parties hereby mutually agree to carry out the human rights support activities described in this Agreement in accordance with (1) the terms of this Agreement, including any annexes attached hereto, and (2) any general agreement between the two governments regarding economic or technical cooperation.

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- 3. Amount of AID Grant: USD 3,000.
 - 4. Grantee Contribution to the Project: The Supreme Court of Guinea on behalf of the Grantee will contribute:
 - A) Library space (room/s) sufficient to house materials donated under this agreement.
 - B) All security necessary to ensure that donated materials are properly preserved and utilized.
 - C) All requisite bookshelves or bookcasing for the storage of donated materials.

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5. Project Assistance Completion Date: September 30, 1993.

6. This agreement consists of these Title pages, Annex A (Project Description) and Annex B (Standard Provisions).



1. Project Title: Democracy and Human Rights.
2. AID Project Number: 698-0541.75
3. Project Description:

A) General Description:

This phase of the Democracy and Human Rights Project will contribute legal reference material toward the establishment of a law library at the Supreme Court.

B) Contribution of the Parties:

- 1) American Embassy: USD 3,000 for the purchase of Guinean law texts and codes, and other legal reference materials.
- 2) Grantee: The Supreme Court, on behalf of the Republic of Guinea, will provide:
 - A) Space sufficient to house materials donated under this agreement.
 - B) All security necessary to ensure that donated materials are properly preserved and utilized.
 - C) All requisite bookshelves or bookcasing for the storage of donated materials.

C) Implementation and Administration:

1) Administration:

The Supreme Court will administer the establishment of the library. The American Embassy will provide funding for the purchase, shipment and delivery of above materials to the Supreme Court. The American Embassy will not be involved in any other administrative matters concerning the establishment of the library or the use of the materials.

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PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND TERMS
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2) Procurement:

The procurement of all commodities will be the responsibility of The American Embassy.

3) Implementation Schedule:

A) Agreement signed: September 1992

B) Order of commodities: No later than January, 1993.

C) Delivery of commodities: No later than August 31, 1993.

4. Conditions Precedent to Disbursement:

Prior to the first disbursement under the grant, or to the issuance by the American Embassy of documentation pursuant to which disbursement will be made, the grantee will, except as the parties may otherwise agree in writing, furnish to the American Embassy, in form and substance satisfactory to the American Embassy:

1) A statement certifying that all requisite facilities, as specified in Section 3.B.2 of this Annex, have been prepared by the Grantee and will be available at the time of delivery of purchased materials.

5. Disbursements:

All funds provided under this Agreement will be disbursed upon the receipt of invoices and adequate supporting documentation for procured commodities.

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6. Source and Origin of Goods: Nationality of Suppliers of Services:

All goods and services financed under this Agreement shall have (with respect to goods) their source and origin and (with respect to suppliers of services) their nationality. In countries included in the Geographic Code 935 as it is applied at the time, the contracts are signed or orders are placed for such goods and except as the American Embassy may otherwise agree in writing..

7. Representatives:

For all purposes relevant to this Agreement, the Grantee will be represented by the individual holding or acting in the office of the President of the Supreme Court. The American Embassy will be represented by the individual serving or acting as the Ambassador. Each of the representatives may, by written notice, designate additional representative(s) for all purposes other than amending the Agreement. The name(s) of any such designated representative(s) of the Grantee, with specimen signature(s), will be provided to the American Embassy, which may thereafter accept as duly authorized any instrument signed by such representative(s) in the implementation of the Agreement, until receipt of written notice of revocation of the authority.

8. Amendment:

This Agreement may be amended by the mutual agreement, in writing, of the Parties heretofore cited.
