



- C) 1. A I D will make available the amount specified in Block 3 of this Agreement, as necessary for the project, as may be further described in Annex A.
2. The Grantee will make available the amount specified in Block 4 of this Agreement, as necessary for the project, as may be further described in Annex A.
- D) A I D shall expend funds and carry on operations pursuant to this Agreement only in accordance with the applicable laws and regulations of the United States Government.
- E) The present Agreement shall enter into force when signed. Either party may terminate this Agreement by giving other party thirty (30) days written notice of intention to terminate it. Termination of this Agreement shall terminate any obligations of the two parties to make contributions pursuant to Blocks 3 and 4 of this Agreement, except for payments which they are committed to make pursuant to noncancellable commitments entered into with third parties prior to the termination of the Agreement.

3. ACTIVITY DESCRIPTION

a) This activity provides manpower development support to the health, and agricultural sectors, as well as training to strengthen the administrative and management capacities of the Congo.

b) In the health sector, working through the Ministry of Health and Social Affairs, health specialists will participate in various training programs in the United States or other countries chosen by USAID. These training programs will be in priority areas of health service provision and program management.

c) In the agricultural and rural improvement area, working through the Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock, and the Ministry of Waters and Forests, agricultural specialists will participate in various training programs in the United States or other countries chosen by USAID. These training programs will be in the areas of agricultural extension services, rural development studies, and forestry.

d) In the management field, working through Congolese management and planning agencies, planners and administrators will participate in various training programs intended to strengthen the Congo's ability to administer its human, fiscal and rural resources.

4. SPECIAL PROVISIONS

A) Prior to the commencement of training, the grantee will furnish to AID, in form and substance satisfactory to AID:

- evidence that the salaries to those persons selected for training will continue during the training period;

- evidence that those persons selected for training will return to the same or higher positions within their respective Ministries.

B) Reference to "this Agreement" means the original Project Agreement as modified by any revisions which have entered into effect. Reference to "cooperating country" means the country territory of the Grantee.
