IMPROVED HEALTH STATUS

WHEREAS, USAID and the Grantee (the "Parties") executed the Assistance Agreement on September 28, 2010, and subsequently amended the same on March 30, 2011 (as amended, referred to herein as the "Agreement"). This Agreement replaced the Strategic Objective Grant Agreement for Strategic Objective No. 7: Health, Population and Nutrition, 641-007 ("SOAG No. 7"), dated September 15, 2003, as amended, in its entirety.

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Agreement is to set out the understandings of the Parties to work together to: improve delivery of health service at the community, district, and regional levels, including interventions to encourage positive behavior change, improve the quality of service delivery and strengthen health systems within each of the seven following Program Elements: HIV/AIDS, Malaria, Maternal and Child Health, Family Planning and Reproductive Health, Water Supply and Sanitation, Nutrition, and Higher Education.

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to increase the amount of USAID's contribution to the Assistance Agreement by Seventy Million Five Hundred Eighty-Five Thousand, Nine Hundred and Fifty-Four U.S. Dollars (\$70,585,954). Thirty-Eight Million One Forty Two Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty-Seven U.S. Dollars (\$38,142,767) will be obligated directly into the Assistance Agreement. Thirty-Two Million Four Hundred Forty-Three Thousand One Hundred Eighty-Seven U.S. Dollars (\$32,443,187) will be obligated by USAID/Washington for activities that support the objectives of the Assistance Agreement. With this obligation, USAID will have committed a total amount to date of Three Hundred Nineteen Million Six Hundred Fourteen Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-Nine U.S. Dollars (\$319,614,829).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Agreement is hereby amended as set forth below:

1. **USAID Contribution**

Delete existing paragraph (a) in Section 3.1. of the Agreement in its entirety and replace with the following:

**Section 3.1. USAID Contribution.**

(a) **The Grant.** To help achieve the Objective set forth in this Agreement, USAID, pursuant to the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, hereby grants to the Grantee under the terms of this Agreement an amount of Three Hundred Nineteen Million Six Hundred Fourteen Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-Nine U.S. Dollars (\$319,614,829), of which One Hundred and Ninety-Four Million, Six Hundred and Twenty-Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-Seven U.S. Dollars (\$194,628,777) is being obligated incrementally and directly under this Agreement, and One Hundred Twenty-Four Million, Nine Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand, Eighty-Two U.S. Dollars (\$124,986,082) has been obligated directly by USAID/Washington.

**Section 3.2 Grantee Contribution**

USAID and the Government of Ghana agree to renew consultations on identifying the Government of Ghana's contributions, in cash or kind, to implementation of the assistance under this amended agreement.

2. **Illustrative Finance Plan**

Delete the current Annex 1 – “Illustrative Financial Plan Table” in its entirety and replace with the Annex 1 – “Illustrative Financial Plan Table” attached to this amendment.

3. **Other Terms and Conditions**

Except as further amended, all other terms and conditions in the Agreement, as amended, remain in full force and effect.


