## SERBIA AND MONTENEGRO WORK PLAN

### PILLAR ACTIVITY – (I) ANIMAL RESPONSE

Based on communications with USAID/Serbia personnel and the USAID E&E regional coordinator, the STOP AI Project proposes 2 activities during 2008 to assist Serbian government staff in preparing for and responding to a possible outbreak of highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI).

#### **ACTIVITY I: TRAINING ON USAID AI COMMODITIES WITH ToT**

This 5-day training course would be held in or around Belgrade. It would be attended by up to 15 government staff from Serbia and up to 5 from Montenegro, as selected by the Mission. The training would be held in a classroom setting, and cover:

- Proper use and disposal of USAID-supplied personal protective equipment kits
- Proper use of USAID-supplied decontamination kits
- Proper use of USAID-supplied laboratory kits
- Comprehensive training of trainers (ToT) instruction
- Compliance with IATA infectious substance shipping standards (provided for laboratory personnel only).

#### **ACTIVITY I.1: SHADOWED TRAINING ON USAID COMMODITIES**

Two additional 2-day training course would be held outside Belgrade immediately following the completion of Activity I. The Mission would select up to 20 participants to attend the training. Training events would be led by selected graduates of Activity I, who would be observed and coached by STOP AI technical staff. The course material would be the same as that used in Activity I, but would not include ToT or IATA training.
