In FY07, Luapula Foundation prepared for the Counseling and Testing (CT) activities by training 90 lay counselors in Mansa, Kawambwa, Samfya and Mwense Districts. There is one service outlet in Mansa town, and the CT in the four districts is mobile, managed from the central outlet. For FY08, in Mansa district, NPI project for CT is being implemented beyond the radius of 70 kilometers of Mansa town because Luapula Foundation is also implementing SFH New Start CT project. Whilst in the Samfya district, CT activities are being implemented in Central, Lubwe and Kasaba sites, in Mwense district, Mulundu and Central sites and in Kawambwa district, Central and Kazembe sites. The total target for CT is 7,500 clients
