FISCAL YEAR 1975

GENERAL INTRODUCTION

Section 657 calls for a myriad of information on U.S. foreign assistance and other transactions. The statute contemplates a comprehensive picture of U.S. dealings with foreign countries, both economically and militarily, and including assistance activities, commercially-oriented trade and sales transactions, payments to international organizations, local currency receipts and expenditures.

This year's report is divided into five sections, each covering one specific area of total U.S. foreign involvement:

A. Economic and Military Assistance

Part I consists of data on foreign economic and military assistance and includes all transactions intended for development purposes and/or offered on concessional terms.

B. Other Transactions

Part II consists of data on trade and sales transactions not conducted on concessional bases and not for the purpose of assisting the recipient.

Part III sets out the assessments paid to international organizations in which the United States participates pursuant to treaties, conventions, or specific acts of Congress. Assessed contributions are our "membership dues" to these organizations.

Part IV consists of data on the income and outgo of U.S.-owned foreign currencies and the purposes for which such currencies are used.

Part V which is distinct from the rest of the report, consists of data on all implements of war exported under any export license, including additional data concerning exports of significant defense articles required by the December 17, 1973 amendment to Section 657 (P.L. 93-189). This part will be submitted at a later date.

Each table is preceded by explanatory notes. Following Part IV is a supplement summarizing certain guaranties and insurance which are not government-to-government, and are therefore not required by the statute, but which are shown for the sake of completeness.

Parts I through IV were prepared by the Statistics and Reports Division, Office of Financial Management, Agency for International Development, working in cooperation with numerous Executive Branch departments and agencies. Part V will be compiled by the Office of Munitions Control, Bureau of Politico-Military Affairs, Department of State.

PART I A -- FOREIGN ECONOMIC ASSISTANCE

Explanatory Notes

The data included in this table represent the aggregate dollar value of all economic grants and credits provided by the United States which qualify as Official Development Assistance. Official Development Assistance (ODA) is all government financial resources intended for development purposes offered on concessional terms.

A.I.D.

Includes obligations and loan authorizations to finance the import of commodities, capital or technical assistance, excluding contributions to international organizations.

Food for Peace (PL 480)

Sales - Amounts authorized under credit sales agreements under Title I of PL 480, for dollars or for convertible currencies, excluding initial payments in dollars.

Donations - Represents shipment levels under Title II of PL 480 for emergency relief and economic development, including transfers to the World Food Program as well as donations through voluntary relief agencies and programs administered by UNICEF and UNRWA.

Peace Corps

Includes obligations incurred for the operation of the overseas volunteer program of ACTION.

Other Grants and Voluntary Contributions to International Organizations

Includes the following:

Capital subscriptions (paid-in) to international financial institutions, including payments for maintenance of value.

Voluntary Contributions to International Organizations.

Other Grants, e.g. Darien Gap, Inter-American Foundation, Trust Territories of the Pacific Islands, International Narcotics Control Program, etc.

Explanatory Notes

The data in this table represent annual program levels.

Military Assistance Program (MAP)

Grants of military equipment, supplies, and services purchased with Foreign Assistance Act Funds.

Military Assistance Service Funded (MASF)

All defense articles and services programmed for transfer to foreign countries or international organizations under authority contained in the Department of Defense Appropriation Act, including International Military Headquarters and MAAGs, Missions and Military Groups.

Foreign Military Sales (FMS) Credits

Credit sales directly financed by the U.S. Government under provisions of the Foreign Military Sales Act. (Excludes private credits guaranteed by the USG under provisions of the FMS Act.)

Other Transfers of Defense Property

Excess Defense Articles - Represents equipment and supplies excess to the requirements of the U.S. military departments granted to countries without charge to MAP-appropriated funds, valued at the original acquisition cost.

Facilities Transfers - Direct transfer by the Department of Defense of U.S. military buildings, fixtures, and other facilities to a foreign government.

Ships Loaned and Leased - Transfer of vessel or boat of the United States to a foreign country or international organization.
