**Communication Improvements for APROFAM
AND Transferring Skills to the Region**

The purpose of a buy-in to the Population Communication Services project with Johns Hopkins University would be to assist APROFAM to improve its mass media population communications capabilities to serve as a regional center. The objective is that Central American countries use video oriented mass media materials to provide information to couples about where they can obtain voluntary family planning services and also to improve program management.

By strengthening an existing local production center, costs of media messages will be reduced and their effectiveness will be increased because the messages are consistent with the local culture and program management needs. Well prepared video messages directed to the public at prime listening times would greatly increase information couples need to make informed decisions on contraception. And videos prepared to help organizations use new computer technology would greatly improve program management.

The center will produce commercially viable materials for sale so that the center is self supporting by year 6.

The Johns Hopkins University contract will provide the technical guidance and equipment to APROFAM, and will be joined by other LAC and S&T population staff and communication contractors to insure broad based support from Washington.

It is assumed that APROFAM will become the Central American regional center of excellence in matters dealing with the production of video oriented population mass media materials. In support of its regional image, a high-level advisory group composed of prominent media owners/managers from other Central American countries will be appointed. Personnel of the highest professional quality will be hired to ensure strong staffing for the video oriented center.

A total of \$650,000 will be provided for the 5 year buy-in. Of this, Johns Hopkins University will receive 20% or \$130,000 over a five year period to cover technical support costs. In addition to the \$650,000 provided through this buy-in, Johns Hopkins will provide \$130,000 for management of this subproject under the S&T financed worldwide cooperative agreement for population communication. A small amount of funds will be used for reviewing and market testing existing materials to confirm their impact on the intended target audience.

As is the case with all S&T/POP buy-ins, the project CTO ^{in S&T/POP} remains the sole project manager. LAC/DR/P, Maura Brackett or designee will be the liaison for the subproject in the LAC Bureau. USAID/Guatemala will provide additional technical guidance as required.
