1. Pursuant to Section 103 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 as amended, I hereby authorize the centrally funded Market and Technology Access Project involving planned obligations of not to exceed \$2,375,000 grant funds over a 5 year period from date of authorization, subject to the availability of funds in accordance with the A.I.D. OYB/allotment process, to help in financing foreign exchange and local currency costs for the project.

2. The project consists of applied research and field trials to identify, test and evaluate methods of promoting collaborative ventures between small and medium U.S. firms and LDC firms. These project activities will seek to develop viable institutional channels that improve the access of LDC firms to new technologies and markets.

3. Special conditions of approval. - None

4. Source and Origin of Goods and Services

a. Each developing country where training or other assistance takes place under this project shall be deemed to be a cooperating country for the purpose of permitting local cost financing.

b. Goods and services, except for ocean shipping, financed by A.I.D. under the project shall have their source and origin in a cooperating country or in the United States except as A.I.D. may otherwise agree in writing.

c. Ocean shipping financed by A.I.D. under the project shall, except as A.I.D. may otherwise agree in writing, be financed only on flag vessels of the United States.

5. Mission add-ons

I authorize up to \$3,000,000 of mission add-on funding during LOP.

SUBJECT: Market and Technology Access Project (936-4053)

Problem: We request that you authorize the Market and Technology Access project (936-4053) by signing the attached PAF. This project will be carried out over a five-year period, beginning in FY 83 and ending in FY 88. S&T funding for this project will total \$2,375,000. Mission add-on funding is estimated at \$3,000,000.

Discussion: The Market and Technology Access project was reviewed by the Human Resources Sector Council on April 25, 1983 and unanimously endorsed by the Rural Development members present. In addition, the Technical Subcommittee on Employment and Small Enterprise indicated their unanimous support during the April 15 project committee review. The concerns of the project committee members were incorporated into the PP reviewed by the Sector Council members. There are no outstanding issues.

Recommendation: That you authorize the Market and Technology Access Project for the period and funding levels stated above.
