In spite of the global commitment to the Alma-Ata goal of "Health for All by the Year 2000", progress has been discouraging in many parts of the world. One of the many reasons for this is lack of information; access to information is both critical and fundamental to effective family planning and health care delivery. Much information of potential value to those who are striving to establish or to improve family planning/primary health care services (FP/PHC), is not formally published or is widely scattered in medical journals or books that are difficult to obtain in the places where they are most needed. Without adequate information, health care providers are compelled to "reinvent the wheel" and are unable to apply the lessons learned in previous service delivery programs.

To meet the needs of such people, many organizations that promote or support FP/PHC activities are now publishing a variety of newsletters or reports. These publications vary tremendously:

- o Many are provided free of charge to health workers in the Third World, but may require developed country requestors to pay a subscription fee.
- o Some are monthlies; some are published less frequently.
- o Some are devoted to a particular topic area; others provide information covering several aspects of development.
- o Some provide original articles or essays; others summarize previously reported information.
- o Many systematically identify report sources of information, publications, films or other available resources.
- o Some have been published for years; others may disappear after a few issues.

This list of publications has been prepared with the hope that it will be of value to students and colleagues concerned about FP/PHC in many parts of the world. Titles have been gathered over a period of several years; and although publication information has been updated periodically, some titles may no longer be available.
