

Establishing Model Routine Immunization Demonstration Center

Experience from Jharkhand, India

Background:

- The Maternal and Child Health Integrated Program (MCHIP) is providing technical assistance to India's Universal Immunization Program to improve immunization coverage through quality service delivery.
- The technical assistance focuses on accelerating the scale up of evidence based interventions and best practices in the focus districts of Uttar Pradesh and Jharkhand.
- Demonstration centers (at existing health facilities) were established to serve as cross-learning sites, with technical support from MCHIP to strengthen the immunization system within these health facilities.
- PHC Jamtara (in Jharkhand state) has been developed as a model routine immunization demonstration center covering four major thematic areas: program management, cold chain management, recording, reporting and use of data for action; and immunization safety.


