FOREWORD

A total of 316 Philippine participants received N.E.C. -A. I. D. training in Public Administration during the ten-year period from 1952 through 1961. Most of the participants received their training in the United States although some spent part of their time in Australia, Canada, England, India, Japan, Korea, New Zealand, Puerto Rico, Taiwan, and Thailand.

In addition, although not included in this directory, there were a number of participants from free-world countries, particularly in the Far East area, who were welcomed to the Philippines where they received training through the Institute of Public Administration or through the N.E.C. -A. I. D.

This directory is being published and distributed to those participants who have received Public Administration training during this ten-year period, and to all interested parties, to present visual evidence of the individual achievements of the Public Administration participants. These accomplishments are important in light of the fact that the economic growth and social development of the Philippines is largely dependent upon an adequate Public Administration by honest, efficient and dedicated administrative personnel.

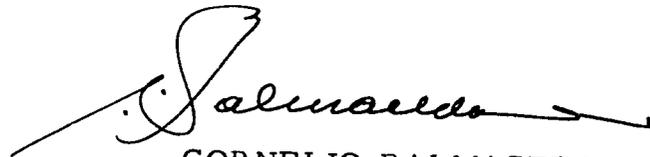

THE SCOPE AND SIGNIFICANCE OF PHILIPPINE TRAINING IN PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION

Public Administration is a relatively young discipline. In the United States, it developed, as such, in the early decades of the present century. In the Philippines, the term Public Administration was seldom heard before World War II. As a matter of fact, the joint N. E. C. -A. I. D. program was largely responsible for its general introduction, primarily through the establishment of the Institute of Public Administration in the University of the Philippines (1952) and through its participant training program.

The influence of the Institute, through its undergraduate, graduate and various training programs is having a profound and long term beneficial effect upon the quality of Philippine Administration. For the short run, the N. E. C. -A. I. D. participant training program has been responsible for many of the specific, and substantial, betterments in organization and procedures within the Government.

The impact of this training is being reflected in the development and use of modern management concepts which are replacing much of the old, bureaucratic methods. An attitude of professionalism is clearly growing within the ranks of Philippine civil servants and officials. Most encouraging are the daily evidences of desire to improve the organization and operations as a means of achieving greater program implementation and reduced costs.

Noteworthy, also, is the fact that this trend towards better administration of the public business is keeping the Philippine Government closely abreast with the movement for better management in private business. This is extremely important in a country where Government necessarily plays such a dominant role in economic development.

Of the 316 N. E. C. -A. I. D. participants who received specialized training in Public Administration in the United States, as well as other countries, 8 are deceased, 4 are retired, 4 are in private employment, and 300 are still in the government service as of June 30, 1961. This latter point is particularly noteworthy, when it is remembered that the salary levels and other benefits of private employment for management-trained personnel are much higher than those of the government. Clearly, also this outstanding record speaks well of the dedication of the Filipino participants in Public Administration.

The major areas or fields of training pursued by these 316 Public Administration participants may be summarized as follows:

Study of the activities of the participants after their return will reveal the tremendous scope and general importance of the work on which they are engaged.

Evidence that the Philippine Government, itself, is making use of the talents developed through the Public Administration phase of the N.E.C. -A. I. D. participant training program is seen in the fact that more than 80% of these participants were promoted to positions of higher responsibility after they returned. A number have received presidential appointments, with a few having already achieved cabinet rank, judicial posts, or election to Congress. Finally, as the Philippines pushed ahead its many-faceted programs of social improvement and economic development, the true measure of the contributions of these, and other, dedicated Filipino civil servants will unfold.
