

INTRODUCTORY NOTE

The National Development Reference Library was conceived by the Agency for International Development to provide a working reference tool in developing countries for planners and executives of programs of social and economic growth and change. The collection, which provides information on the application of human and physical resources to the processes of national growth, has been limited almost entirely to U.S. publications. Subjects range from theories of development planning to village improvement case studies. Titles were selected for the most part for their value to the generalist practitioner, rather than to the specialist or expert.

The initial collection of books was transmitted to selected countries during 1963 and 1964, for use in Economic Development Centers, Planning Boards, Industry Institutes, Libraries, and similar institutions.

During 1964 and 1965, the initial collection was updated with supplementary titles at AID/Washington expense. Since A.I.D. country Missions and host country agencies henceforth are to bear the cost of expansion and replacement items for the Library, the 1966 Supplement lists recent titles recommended by AID/Washington for purchase to bring the Library up to date. For convenience in ordering extra copies for circulation, or for replacement, publishers' list prices are given for books previously supplied, and where books are no longer in print that fact is indicated. Missions may order books through normal A.I.D. procurement channels; other agencies should order through their own procurement facilities, or directly from publishers. Many publishers will grant special discounts from list prices if the National Development Reference Library is mentioned in the order. For a directory of publishers see the annual publication Books in Print, or A Practical Bibliography for developing Areas, Vol. I or II, supplied without charge by A.I.D. upon request.

For the convenience of Missions which need further references in particular fields or wish to recommend or supply additional books to host country agencies, a list of selected sources of reference is also included this year.
