Fiscal Year 1964 Report on Participants  
in the U. S. Government Technical Assistance Program  
and Foreign Short-Term Visitors  
Under Direction of the Technical Assistance Division,  
Office of International Aviation Affairs,  
Federal Aviation Agency

During Fiscal Year 1964, 274 participants from 38 countries received training in the United States under the supervision and direction of the Federal Aviation Agency in the U. S. Government Technical Assistance Program. Four U. S. Government Agencies sponsored the training projects. A summary of the training accomplished by the Federal Aviation Agency, by sponsoring agency, follows:

1. Agency for International Development (AID)

Two hundred and thirty-five government and industry officials representing twenty seven countries received training. Fields of specialization in which training was provided are shown on Table 2. See attached tabulations for detailed information on names and titles of participants, countries, dates of training, fields of specialization, etc.

2. International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO)

Twenty-four officials representing thirteen countries; namely, Burma, China, Egypt, Greece, India, Indonesia, Israel, Mexico, Philippines, Somalia Republic, Sudan, Tanganyika, and Trinidad and Tobago, trained in the United States under the supervision of the Federal Aviation Agency. Fields of specialization in which training was provided are as follows: Accident Investigation, Administration of Civil Aviation, Air Traffic Control, Aircraft Maintenance, Airport Management, Maintenance of Air Navigational Facilities and Flight Operations.

3. Department of State

Thirteen officials representing two countries; namely, Iceland and the Republic of Guinea, received training in the United States under the supervision of the Federal Aviation Agency. Fields of specialization in which training was provided are as follows: Administration of Civil Aviation and Air Traffic Control.

4. Federal Aviation Agency

Two officials representing two countries; namely, Chile and Saudi Arabia, trained in the United States under the sponsorship of the Federal Aviation

Agency. Fields of specialization in which training was provided are as follows: Air Traffic Control and Flight Operations.

#### Casual Visitors

In addition to the participants in the U. S. Government Technical Assistance Program who received training under the supervision of the Federal Aviation Agency, 898 Civil Aviation representatives from other countries called at the FAA offices of International Aviation Affairs in Washington, D. C., Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, New York City, New York, Los Angeles, California, Miami, Florida, and National Aviation Facilities Experimental Center, Atlantic City, New Jersey, for information, advice, technical guidance and/or discussions. Demonstration of U. S. manufactured aviation equipment, including air navigation aids and visits to other FAA offices and facilities and to aviation industrial concerns, were arranged for these visitors.
